


## Inspiring Young People in a Special Educational Setting

### The Challenge

Many of the children at the Center are facing significant challenges when it comes to their educational experience. Many of them struggle to lead a normal life, so attending school means overcoming behavioral disorders such as PTSD, low level attention span and learning disabilities which mean they often learn at a slower pace than their peers. As many of the children require constant attention from teachers and staff the school has limited additional resources to invest in learning materials.

Teaching STEM subjects, and specially the sciences, is particularly challenging because this complex subject has been developed into a curriculum model which unhelpfully fragments subjects into different topics rather than presenting them as a cohesive whole. Although the school district had invested in STEM products these decisions did not always meet the needs of the teaching staff.

## Getting to Know the School
